Instruments and cases will be rented in the best possible condition. Any existing blemishes or damage will be noted at the time of rental.

A few reminders:

- ~ Keep your instrument handy for playing and practicing!
- ~ **Never leave your instrument in a car overnight or in a parked car. This is especially important during our hot summer months!**
- ~ For fiddles and cellos, always remember to release the bow after each practice.
- ~ Never lend your instrument, bow or shoulder rest to anyone.
