

# 7th Grade Supply List

Welcome to a new school year! Below is a list of materials that will be needed throughout the year. They don't need to be brand new, and so hopefully your child can find the majority of supplies already at home. Please bring supplies to school by the first Friday of school.

**A 1.5 inch binder** with 6 **dividers** (dividers with pockets are a bit pricier but worth it) and some **lined paper** (college or wide rule is fine). Please do not label dividers yet. Paper gets heavy, so about 20 pieces of lined paper is plenty and the rest can stay at home for resupplying over time. This binder will be for math and science.

**Loose leaf graph paper** (4 sq/in.). THIS IS A CRITICAL SUPPLY ITEM for math!

**1 composition book (science)** – lined and bound (not spiral)

**1 composition book (Math)** - graph ruled and bound (not spiral)

**1 single subject spiral bound notebook** (Social Studies) - college or wide ruled is fine

**Green Spiral Notebook** (History)

**Green two-pocket folder** (History)

**Yellow Spiral Notebook** (Language Arts)

**Yellow two-pocket folder** (Language Arts)

**1-2 glue sticks**

**Small scissors**

**Scientific Calculator** (math) For 7th graders, it would be nice for students to have a scientific calculator. I like the TI-30ax, and they are under \$10 usually. But any scientific is fine. Be sure to label it with Sharpie and save the directions.

**Pencil pouch** with: 3- 5 sharpened **pencils**, 2-3 blue/black **ball point pens**, 2-3 red/green OR purple **pens** for editing/corrections and 2 different color **highlighters**

**In addition, pouch might want to include:**

**Set of colored pencils** (do not need to be fancy and sharing and/or using class set is fine)
